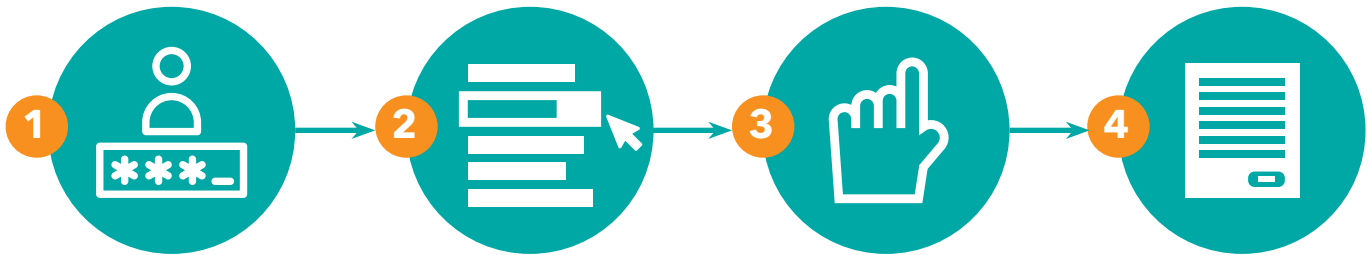
As strategic leaders, the PCI SSC Board of Advisors plays an active role in improving data security around the world.

It must also include information about the organization and how it participates in the payment card industry, as well as why the organization should be elected to the PCI SSC Board of Advisors.

The nomination period runs from 14 September until 26 October 2020
