A Look Into Self-Assessments

- Enhancements to SAQs were based on industry **feedback**
- Guidance and explanations **added**
- Requirements in each SAQ were **updated** to align PCI DSS v4.0
- Attestation of Compliance (AOC) sections updated to **align** with changes made to the Report on Compliance AOC
- Enhanced information **requested** in SAQ D for Service Providers
